<p>Objectives</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will conjugate verbs of every conjugation in the Present Tense. • Students will differentiate between an Ablative prepositional phrase and an Accusative prepositional phrase. • Students will understand when the Vocative Case is appropriate. • Students will understand when a Present Active Infinitive is appropriate. • Students will conjugate the irregular verbs "sum", "possum" and "eo".
