IMPORTANT HEALTH NOTICE

To all Parent(s)/Legal Guardian(s) of
Students Entering 7th through 12th Grade
in the Fall of 2020

Your son or daughter is required by Maryland Immunization Law to submit proof of the following immunizations to the school on or before August 31, 2020.

- **1 dose of Meningococcal Vaccine**
- **1 dose of Tdap Vaccine**
- **3 or 4 doses of Diphtheria, Tetanus, & Pertussis Vaccine**
- **3 doses of Polio Vaccine**
- **2 doses of Measles, Mumps, & Rubella (MMR) Vaccine (after 12 months of age)**
- **3 doses of Hepatitis B Vaccine**
- **1 dose of Varicella (Chickenpox) Vaccine or physician documented proof of disease**

One dose of Varicella (Chickenpox) Vaccine after 12 months of age is required for a student younger than 13 years old. Two doses of Varicella Vaccine after 12 months of age for unvaccinated students 13 years of age or older, or physician documented proof of disease.

No student will be admitted to school unless all the requirements of the immunization law are met.

Additional information on immunization requirements is available from the school nurse.
